PMC shows off revamped Cardiac Rehabilitation Center

Piedmont Medical Center held an open house Thursday for its Cardiac Rehabilitation Center, which recently expanded.

The center, which opened in 1997 with one patient, moved to a much larger location in the hospital this summer and now shares space and additional equipment with physical therapy, said program director Claudia Robinson.

Cardiac rehab, which works on recovery and prevention, treats about 25 patients a day three days a week, and staff members teach in other areas of the hospital on topics such as smoking cessation and diet the other days. "It's become a pretty busy place," said Hicklin, the center's medical director.
